### Maths

The children will develop their fluency with whole numbers and the 4 number operations. They will develop their ability to solve a range of problems. They will analyse shapes and their properties describing the relationships between them.

### Science

Children will compare and group together different kinds of rocks. They will describe how fossils are formed and recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

They will also find out about the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival, and describe the importance of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

### Geography: What A Wonderful World

Children will build on their map skills to recognise human and physical features including famous buildings and other landmarks.
